SRACL is a cooperative effort of the Grayslake, Vernon Hills and Mundelein Park Districts and the Villages of Hawthorn Woods, Lake Zurich, Libertyville and Lincolnshire. Individuals residing within the boundaries of the Member Agencies are considered "residents" of SRACL and may take advantage of the services.

SRACL offers more than 600 weekly programs, special events and camps during the year. SRACL recognizes that some people with disabilities prefer to participate in recreation programs within their own Park District or Recreation Department. SRACL can help you with this opportunity by providing extra staff, if deemed necessary, sign language interpreters, behavior management support, disability awareness training and other adaptive services necessary for safe and successful participation.
