CHEESE AND WINE, ANYONE?

There's nothing like a savory cheese to complement fine wine! Join us to learn how cheese is made and about the fine art of winemaking. Our first stop will be to tour Cedar Grove Cheese, a small local cheese factory that specializes in specialty cheeses. Each morning, Cedar Grove Cheese brings in milk from 24 nearby farms that is made into cheese by the next day. See a glimpse of the cheesemakers' process as they work milk into cheese. Then, enjoy a buffet lunch at Vintage Brewery located on the banks of the Wisconsin River. Our final stop will be to tour the beautiful grounds and enjoy wine tastings at Wollersheim Winery in Prairie du Sac. There will be time to shop and take in the winery, which is a National Historic Site. Trip includes tours, lunch and motor coach transportation. **Moderate to extensive activity.** (SR).

MANSIONS OF LAKE COUNTY

Age: Mature Adults, 55+ years

Shiloh House is an elegant 25-room mansion that was built by Zion's founder, the Reverend John Alexander Dowie, who headed the Christian Catholic Church. After a brief introduction, explore the mansion on a self-guided tour. Now owned and maintained by the Zion Historical Society, the mansion includes artifacts of the period, and many personal items of the late Dr. and Mrs. Dowie. Next, relax with a leisurely lunch of slow roasted chicken at Savanna House Restaurant, named for the lush green forest preserve located directly behind the building. Hear a brief history of the house and Village of Wadsworth. Finally, enjoy a private tour of Loyola's Cuneo Mansion and Gardens, which stands as a monument to old-world elegance amid genteel county life. Commissioned by Samuel Insull, the founder of Commonwealth Edison, this rose-colored villa was completed in 1916, owned and further embellished by the Cuneo family from 1937-1990, and the entire estate was gifted to Loyola University Chicago in 2009. Trip includes transportation by Park District Bus, tours and lunch. **Extensive walking and some stairs.** (SR)

THE TEMPEL LIPIZZANS PERFORMANCE

BOHEMIAN NATIONAL CEMETERY & RED APPLE RESTAURANT

Established by a member of Chicago's Czech community in 1877, the Bohemian National Cemetery is on the National Register of Historic Places and features historic buildings, magnificent mausoleums, monuments, statuary by renowned artists and an astonishing variety of gravestone artistry. The "Tour of the Tombstones" is an approximately two hour, 1.5 mile walking tour led by a professional guide. The tour features a limestone gatehouse, war memorials and even a columbarium specially dedicated to Chicago Cubs fans complete with ivy, bricks and seats from Wrigley Field. After the tour, enjoy the "Award Winning All You Can Eat European Fusion" buffet of traditional and contemporary Polish and international food at Red Apple Restaurant.
