Greenfield Village & the Henry Ford Museum stand as monuments to America's exceptionalism with unequaled collections of artifacts from the history of the United States. This indoor-outdoor complex is one of the premier museums in our country. The Henry Ford Museum (indoor) has vast collections of everything from transportation to household furnishings to iconic artifacts from America's cultural landscape. CAPE COD: MARTHA'S VINEYARD, NANTUCKET & BOSTON
