

Grays Lake Invasive Plant Control Program 2014

The Grays Lake Management Committee has contracted with Marine Biochemists to perform a whole lake chemical application to control invasive plants such as milfoil for the 2014 season. As in the past, a whole lake application will be performed in mid-April and a spot spray, if needed, will be performed in late summer. The spring application last year was very effective and no spot spray was needed last summer.

The application will carry the following restrictions:

No use of lake water for irrigation for 30 days.

No fish consumption for 7 days.

No swimming for 7 days.

Once conditions permit the application to be performed, letters will be distributed to every homeowner along the lake as well as posted at the Jones Island Park and Lake Street access points.
