

CREEKSIDE POND INVASIVE PLANT TREATMENT NOTICE

Working Together to Keep Our Pond Clean, Clear, and Healthy

The Grayslake Community Park District, has contracted with McCloud Aquatics to perform a pond treatment targeting submerged invasive aquatic plants that threaten the health of Creekside pond.

 **Treatment Date: Thursday, August 21, 2025** *(weather permitting)*

Temporary Water Use Restrictions:

- No use of pond water for irrigation for 30 days

Why This Matters

Invasive submerged aquatic plants can:

- Choke out native vegetation
- Reduce water quality
- Hinder the proper operations of the bubblers / fountain
- Disrupt fish and wildlife habitats

Controlling these invasive species helps maintain a balanced ecosystem, supports healthy fish populations, and ensures overall health of the pond.
