

CHESAPEAKE PONDS INVASIVE PLANT TREATMENT NOTICE

The Grayslake Community Park District, has contracted with McCloud Aquatics to perform a pond treatment targeting submerged invasive aquatic plants, mainly Eurasian Milfoil that threaten the health of the Chesapeake ponds.

 **Treatment Date: Friday, September 5, 2025** *(weather permitting)*

 **Temporary Water Use Restrictions:**

- No use of pond water for lawn or garden irrigation for 15 days

 **Why This Matters**

Invasive submerged aquatic plants can:

- Choke out native vegetation
- Reduce water quality
- Disrupt fish and wildlife habitats

Controlling these invasive plants helps maintain a balanced ecosystem, supports healthy fish populations, and ensures overall health of the pond.
